NUS Voices is looking for a Singapore based, accomplished and motivated vocal instructor to join our team and contribute to NUS student life. The vocal instructor will be responsible for tutoring the group, advancing their vocal techniques and proficiency with performing selected Mandopop songs in their concerts.

About NUS Voices:

Established in 1999, NUS Voices is a family of talented instrumentalists and vocalists who share a common passion for performing Mandopop. Voices has put up many performances both on and off campus and has established itself to be more than just another singing club, with proficient band members who also receive ensemble tutoring from an industry practitioner. Voices holds its focus on Chinese pop in their performances.

Key Responsibilities:

- Vocal instruction: Provide structured instruction for NUS Voices vocalists, guided by a strong teaching philosophy with a strong understanding of Mandopop and experience in Mandopop.
- Conduct regular vocal coaching lessons with NUS Voices on a schedule determined with the NUS Voices executive committee
- Provide comprehensive progressive lesson plan, preparing NUS Voices for two concerts per academic year

Qualifications:

- Registered with MOE as a CCA instructor or Art and Music Instructors Scheme (AMIS)
- Demonstrable track record as a vocal instructor with current experience teaching in tertiary institution(s) and at least 10 years of relevant experience in teaching and leadership in the field through private schools and studios and professional companies or collectives
- Active performer in the local/international music industry
- Demonstrable experience with Mandopop as a performer and teacher, and knowledge of Mandopop as an art form, including familiarity with Mandopop songs

- This is a contracted position with flexible hours based on the group's schedule and events.
- Compensation will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
- Shortlisted candidates will be invited to an interview followed by a trial period of six months (one semester)
